<b>Troponin T</b>  Extended measuring range: <b>Roche CARDIAC POC Troponin T</b> REF 07007302190	Early aid in diagnosis of acute myocardial infarction (AMI) and identification of patients with an elevated mortality risk <sup>1-3</sup>	12 min	40–2,000 ng/L	< 50 ng/L – Both typical and atypical symptoms connected with a Troponin T value < 50 ng/L in patients with suspected AMI or in patients presenting with acute chest pain call for the application of further diagnostic measures, including repeated cTnT tests e.g. after 3–6 h to detect rising Troponin T levels <sup>3-5</sup>  ≥ to 50 ng/L – A Troponin T value ≥ 50 ng/L is highly predictive of long-term mortality, irrespective of AMI. Appropriate treatment in the catheterization laboratory, an acute cardiac care unit, or another emergency facility must be ensured <sup>3</sup>
